Scientists have long spoken about human nature's "exploration dynamic" and its ties to genes responsible for learning, curiosity and restlessness. Given that humans are seekers, humanity has entrusted scientists with its trailblazing responsibilities. The journal *Nature* recently published the results of a world-wide survey concluding that investment in science is the key to humanity's well-being and economic growth, and that scientists are seen as more trustworthy than other public figures. But are scientists in any meaningful way aware of their stature in the global public's consciousness, or of their need to maintain the trust with which they are regarded?

Dr. Vasgird is Director of West Virginia University's Office of Research Integrity and Compliance. ORIC's mission is to foster a culture of integrity and ensure that participants in the university's research enterprise internalize and pursue the goal of self-directed responsible conduct of research. Dr. Vasgird was IRB Chair and Senior Research Scientist with the New York City Department of Health; Associate Professor in the School of Public Health and Director of the Office of Responsible Conduct of Research at Columbia University; and Associate Professor in the Department of Preventive Medicine and Community Health at SUNY Downstate Health Sciences Center. He has written and presented extensively in the areas of research ethics and human research protection.
